1. To receive apologies

Apologies were received from Cllr Macdonald-Brown. Apologies were accepted.

4. To consider licence and planning applications received and make recommendations

- **WD/2018/2110/F – Nevill Golf Club, Benhall Mill Road, Frant, TN2 5JW**

Single-storey extension to form new entrance and reception area.

It was considered that the proposed would be a positive addition and councillors were therefore in support of the application.

5. To approve the appointment of an internal auditor for 2018/19

The Clerk informed the Council that she had provisionally engaged a new auditor for this year's audit in line with the Council's Standing Orders. She gave some background and his appointment was **approved**.

6. To approve the quote for retaining solicitors for the new green in Eridge

The Clerk noted that, by the time of the meeting, an exact quote had not yet been received. In view of this and given that Remembrance Sunday was fast approaching, it was **resolved** that any quote up to a maximum of £4000 should be taken as approved by this minute. If the quote breached that amount, it was agreed to review this at the next meeting.

7. To consider refurbishment proposals for BYG Cricket Club

It was agreed that the Cricket Club was a positive resource in the Parish. It was further agreed that if the Cricket Club approached the Parish Council with a specific proposal with costs, councillors could consider their request in more depth. Cllr Wallis to feed this back to the Club. **Action: SW**

8. To approve accounts payable

The accounts to be paid were approved.

Turning to the Remembrance Sunday events, Cllr Stevens said he thought the Abergavenny family would be attending the unveiling of the new green in Eridge. The Clerk explained the format for the service at the Memorial Hall in Frant and it was agreed the Parish Council would serve refreshments and Cllr Rutherford would say a few words before the school choir performed.
